Winemaker's Comments:

Unique wine of the noble rot category. This winemaking process dictates that the most mature grapes be allowed to shrivel naturally and be affected by the botrytis mould. The result is a rich concentrated dessert wine whose complex tones treats the palate to hints of nutmeg, clove, honey, apricot and citrus. It can be served with all sweet meals and after dinner indulgences.
