2006 marks the second vintage of Russian River Valley Pinot Noir for Dovetail. In all, over half a dozen blocks of Pinot Noir from various sites around the Russian River were each fermented separately, utilizing indigenous yeasts, and then aged in french and hungarian barrels. Once each lot's character had emerged, numerous combinations of the components were tasted until this particular blend stood alone above the crowd!

Tasting Notes:

Crystal clear in the glass, the dark red color has traces of blackness. Aromas of spiced cherry and sweet amaretto-like almond fill the nose while hints of minerals and smoke peak in from the background. Plush, polished, and juicy on the palate, this wine fills the mouth without a hard edge in sight and finishes strong with lingering fruit and a gentle tingling of acid. Very stylish and classic style of balanced Pinot Noir that will enhance a wide range of your favorite dishes!
