THE WINE

2006 Roux is the first red wine released under the Trou de Bonde label. Inspired by the French term "Roux", meaning mixture, it is a proprietary blend consisting of 58% Petite Sirah, 35% Zinfandel, and 7% Tempranillo. Dried cherries, vanilla and Christmas spices on the nose, are followed by bright red and dark fruits on the palate. This medium to heavy weight wine should pair nicely with a variety of meat dishes, from lamb stew to beef or turkey burgers.
